April 11, 2022

The Jefferson County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on April 11, 2022. Present were Commissioners Lynn Luck, Richard Malm, David Christy and County Clerk, Linda M Buttron. County Counselor Josh Ney was also present.

Vouchers were reviewed and approved by the Counselor and the Board. David moved that the minutes of April 4 be approved as presented. Lynn seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Dustin Parks, Community Development Director met with the Board. The Board signed a travel request to travel to Mulvane Kansas for the Kansas Association of Planning & Zoning Conference. He discussed statistics for the department. There have been 58 building permits since January 1 and approximately 98 email conversations regarding splitting property. After the last Commission meeting, a representative from Mammoth Sports Construction LLC came by the office for discussion. The representative stated that they were working on a survey development plan. Dustin gave an update on the Washington street subdivision case. The final plat has been received for review.

The Board discussed a resolution regarding maintenance on minimum maintenance roads. David moved that the Board recess into executive session to discuss matters of legal advice with Dustin to attend as part of the collective client. Richard seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. The Board recessed at 1:15 p.m. Present during the session were Dustin, Josh and the Board. The Board reconvened at 1:24 p.m. and announced they would extend until 1:30 p.m. The Board reconvened at 1:30 p.m. The chair announced that no binding action was taken during executive session.
