

**UNOFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF  
COMMISSIONERS**

June 18, 2020

The Jefferson County Commissioners met in special session on Thursday June 18. Present were Commissioners Lynn Luck, Richard Malm & Wayne Ledbetter and County Clerk Linda M Buttron. James Tweed, Emergency Services Director and Crystal Vanhoutan Local Health Officer were also present.

Crystal reported that as of today there are no active COVID cases in Jefferson County. She recommended that while the virus is still active, the metrics have been met for the County to move to the Phase Out option of the Governor's plan beginning Monday June 22. The main changes in this phase include: removing the restrictions on mass gatherings, still recommending that individuals adhere to personal hygiene guidelines (hand washing and sanitizing) and remain home if sick, employers should follow any additional guidance provided for business and employees, travel is unrestricted except for those states that are noted by the CDC for travel restriction. If people travel to those designated states they would need to quarantine for 2 weeks. Crystal commended her staff for all the hours they have put in monitoring cases and providing public health guidance and working with the schools. The Board agreed to her recommendations by consensus. The new phase will take effect on Monday June 22.

James and the Board briefly discussed the Spark Funding being distributed by the State.

The special meeting adjourned at 9:18 a.m.
