

**UNOFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

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March 29, 2021

The Jefferson County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday March 29, 2021. Present were Commissioners Lynn Luck, Richard Malm, David Christy, County Clerk Linda M Buttron and Ryan Kriegshauser, Assistant County Counselor.

Vouchers were reviewed and approved by the Assistant Counselor and the Board. David moved that the minutes of March 22 be approved as presented. Lynn seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Lisa Buerman, Treasurer met with the Board. Lisa requested that the Board advertise the following lots for sale and that minimum bids be set at \$300 per lot: Lots 5, 6 & 7 Block G Westshore Estates, Lots 1, 2 & 3 Block A-Hilldale Subdivision, Lots 728 & 729 Lakewood Hills, Lots 3, 4 & 5 Block G Hilldale South and Lots 10 & 11 Block L Lakeshore Estates. Lynn moved that the lots be advertised for sale and the minimum bid be set at \$300 per lot. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Richard moved that the Board recess into executive session to discuss matters of non-elected personnel regarding an evaluation until 1:10 p.m. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. The Board recessed at 1:04 p.m. Present during the session was the Board. The Board reconvened at 1:10 p.m. The chair announced that no binding action was taken during executive session.

Marion Anderson, 16946 13<sup>th</sup> Street, met with the Board. Marion addressed questions to the Board regarding the fence view done on February 24th. She asked who was responsible for maintenance of the fence. She said that a Commissioner had explained the "right hand rule" to her at the viewing but she was still unsure who should maintain what parts of the fence. Lynn stated that the Board would have Ryan look up the maintenance question and send her a letter.
