

UNOFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Jefferson County Board of Commissioners convened in regular session on Monday, June 17th at 1:00 p.m. Present were Commissioners Wayne Ledbetter, Lynn Luck, Richard Malm, County Counselor Josh Ney and County Clerk Linda M Buttron.

Vouchers were reviewed and approved by the Counselor and the Board. Lynn moved that the minutes of June 10th be approved as presented. Richard seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Bill Noll, Public Works Director met with the Board. Bill asked the Board to sign notification to the State of Casey Keirns appointment as the Noxious Weed Supervisor. The Board signed the required documents. Crew work was discussed. Bill requested permission to bid on crack sealing melting pot on Purple Wave. Permission was given by consensus. Bill discussed possible impacts to roads currently under water from flooding.

Bill Noll requested an executive session. Wayne moved that the Board adjourn into executive session to discuss matters of land acquisition until 1:25 p.m. Lynn seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. The Board adjourned at 1:15 p.m. Present during the session were Bill, Josh and the Board. At 1:25 p.m. the chair announced that the session would be extended for five more minutes with the same parties present. The Board reconvened at 1:30 p.m. The chair announced no binding action was taken during executive session.

A public hearing was held at 1:30 p.m. regarding vacation of drainage easements for property in Rynita Gwen Subdivision. Wayne opened the public hearing. Applicant Christopher Yoder was present for the discussion. The chair asked for public comment. None was heard. The chair announced the closure of the public hearing. Lynn moved that the vacation request of the drainage easements of Rynita Gwen Sub be granted. Richard seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

The Board adjourned as the Board of Commissioners at 1:34 p.m.

The Jefferson County Land Bank convened at 1:34 p.m. Jason Klenklen was present. He wishes to purchase Lots 53, 54 & 55 Block Q Lake Ridge Estates. The sale of the lots has been published in the County paper as required. The lot price was negotiated and a price of \$300 per lot was agreed on. Wayne moved that the bid of \$300 per lot be accepted for the lots. Lynn seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

The Land Bank Board adjourned at 1:38 p.m.
