

UNOFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

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August 22, 2022

The Jefferson County Commissioners met in regular session on August 22, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. Present were Commissioners Richard Malm, Lynn Luck and David Christy. Linda Buttron, County Clerk and Josh Ney were also present. (1:47 pm)

Vouchers were reviewed and approved by the Counselor and the Board. Lynn moved that the minutes of August 15 be approved as presented. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Dustin Parks, Community Development Director reported that there is a Planning Commission meeting tonight. Dustin discussed cases to be heard.

Ben Domann, Public Works Director met with the Board. He has had contact with Bettis Asphalt (Mid State Materials) quarry in Nortonville. They still not asphalted the 100' stretch to the road that is required under their Conditional Use Permit. He asked Board to authorize a letter be sent asking them to get the asphalt done. David moved a letter be sent. Lynn seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. Ben stated that the courthouse roof replacement should be done on Wednesday.

Treasurer Lisa Buerman presented bids to open for County lots. Jerry White bid \$300 on Lot 22 Block K Lakeside Village and \$300 on Lot 23 Block K Lakeside Village. Richard moved the bids be accepted. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. Lynn moved that the Board approve the issuance of a treasurer's check today to pay the filing fee. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. Jeff Dugan bid \$350 on Lot 1 Blk J Lake Ridge Estates and \$350 on Lot 6 Block F Lake Ridge Estates. Lynn moved that the bids be accepted. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Lynn moved that the Board appoint Kim Swearngin to the Sarcoxie Township Board to finish the term of Marti Shaw as Township Trustee. Marti resigned earlier this year. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Lynn moved that Linda be appointed as the voting delegate for the KCAMP and KWORCC Annual meetings in October. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. Lynn moved that Richard be designated as the alternate delegate for those meetings. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Kari Kearney & Terry Bellinger met with the Board. Kari asked questions about the 2023 budget. Terry also asked questions regarding how the budget process works. He would like some education on how the budgets and mill levies work.

There being no further business to come before the Board they adjourned to meet in regular session on August 29th.
