

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-33

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas met in regular session on the 14th day of December, 2015.

WHEREAS, it has been determined to be in the best interests of Jefferson County and public safety that regulatory signs to control the use of engine exhaust brakes, also known as jake brakes, be placed at appropriate locations along Lecompton Rd. between its intersections with US-24 Highway and 12th Street located in sections 26 and 23, Township 11 South, Range 18 East of the 6th P.M.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2001 et seq. requires that regulatory signs be authorized by the local jurisdictional authority; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas is the local jurisdictional authority for roadways within the unincorporated areas of Jefferson County, Kansas;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, that regulatory signs to control the use of engine exhaust brakes, also known as jake brakes, be placed at appropriate locations along Lecompton Rd. between its intersections with US-24 Highway and 12th Street located in sections 26 and 23, Township 11 South, Range 18 East of the 6th P.M.
