A RESOLUTION CONCERNING JOINT GOVERNMENTAL PURCHASES

The Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas (Board) met in regular session on the 2nd day of November 2015, with the following Commissioners present; Richard Malm, Wayne Ledbetter, and Lynn Luck; for the purpose of transacting such business that might come before the Board.

WHEREAS, the Board has considered a proposal from county departmental heads concerning joint governmental purchases made through the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA);

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that joint governmental purchases may be made with other counties, townships, and cities pursuant to K.S.A. 12-2908; and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Purchasing Policy provides that competitive bid/proposal may be waived when purchases are made in cooperation with other city, county, state, or federal agencies and it is deemed to be in the best interest of the County to purchase supplies, services and equipment from contracts and agreements of other governmental agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board that Jefferson County enter into a Joint Governmental Purchasing agreement with NJPA for the purpose of purchasing county equipment and/or supplies.
