

RESOLUTION 2018-014

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, has established Sanitary Sewer District No. 6 (Lakeshore Estates), Jefferson County, Kansas ("District") pursuant to K.S.A. 19-27a01 et seq. and Jefferson County Resolution No. 80-11A; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 19-27a01(a), serves as the governing body of the District;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, has determined that it is in the public interest to standardize the management of the District consistent with the management of other sewer districts in the county;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas;


1. The ongoing management of Sewer District No. 6 (Lakeshore Estates) shall be conducted by the Jefferson County Health Department;
2. Crystal Van Houtan, Administrator & County Health Officer, Jefferson County Health Department, or her successor in title, is authorized as a signatory on all accounts for District;
3. Crystal Van Houtan, or her successor in title, is appointed as administrator of District the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, and shall manage all issues, payments, receipts, and other financial and administrative matters for District.


This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication in the official County newspaper.
