

# Resolution 2020-018

*A resolution establishing that Jefferson County Emergency Management Staff are eligible for overtime pay and benefits during State and Federally declared disasters.*

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 502 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. 5121-5207 (the "Stafford Act"), eligible emergency protective measures taken to respond to the COVID-19 emergency at the direction or guidance of public health officials may be reimbursed under Category B of FEMA's Public Assistance Program.

WHEREAS, State, territorial, tribal and local government entities and certain private non-profit organizations are eligible to apply for Public Assistance, and

WHEREAS, Public Assistance Category B reimbursements can include Emergency Operation Center costs and reimbursement for state, tribe, territory and/or local government force account overtime costs among other expenses,

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT, the Jefferson County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes all staff of the Emergency Management department to receive regular salary and overtime pay in the event of a State or Federally Declared Disaster.

Such payment will include any duties that the staff, including Keith A. Jeffers, Emergency Manager, is performing as part of their positions, including any deployments outside of the Jefferson County jurisdiction, as a member of any Disaster Team or Incident Management Team.


