

Resolution 2020-024
COVID 19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of March, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas declared there was a state of local public health emergency in Jefferson County, Kansas resulting in potential or occurring Pandemic known as COVID 19, in Jefferson County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, this declaration was extended until April 19 by action of the County Commissioners at their meeting on April 6, 2020, and

WHEREAS, this declaration was again extended until May 1 by the County Commissioners in their meeting on April 13, 2020, and

WHEREAS, this declaration was again extended until July 15th by the County Commissioners in their meeting on May 4, 2020, and.

WHEREAS, such conditions endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas:

That the state of local public health emergency in Jefferson County, Kansas declared on the 16th day of March, 2020, **shall continue and remain in effect until the State of Kansas rescinds the State of Disaster Emergency Proclamation signed on May 26, 2020** unless terminated earlier.

That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Jefferson County, Kansas and shall initiate the rendering of aid and assistance there under.

That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law until the State of Kansas rescinds the State of Disaster Emergency Proclamation signed on May 26, 2020 unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.
