

RESOLUTION 2010-007

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 35 MPH ON 94TH ROAD GOING EASTERLY AND WETERLY FROM A POINT WHERE 94TH ROAD INTERSECTS WITH THE FERGUSON RAOD TO A POINT WHERE 94TH ROAD INTERSECTS WITH KINGMAN ROAD, ALL BEING WITHIN RURAL JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Jefferson, Kansas has the authority to regulate, warn and guide traffic upon all streets, road and highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety and because of bridge construction, the County Commissioners of Jefferson County Kansas have determined that it would enhance public safety to establish a temporary maximum speed limit of 35 MPH on 94th road going easterly and westerly from a point where 94th road intersects with Ferguson road to a point where 94th road intersects with Kingman Road, all being within rural Jefferson County, Kansas;

IT IS THE FINDING AND RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that, in the interest of public safety and due to bridge construction, that a temporary maximum speed limit of 35 MPH shall be established for 94th road going easterly and westerly form a point where 94th road intersects with Ferguson road to a point where 94th road intersects with Kingman Road, all being within rural Jefferson County, Kansas and that signs designating said speed limit be posted by the Jefferson County Highway Department at appropriate locations.

This resolution shall become effective upon publication in the official county newspaper and posting of said signs.
