

RESOLUTION 2010-014

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 35 MPH ON KIOWA ROAD GOING NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY FROM A POINT WHERE KIOWA ROAD INTERSECTS WITH K-92 HIGHWAY TO A POINT WHERE KIOWA ROAD INTERSECTS WITH 94TH STREET, ALL BEING WITHIN RURAL JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Jefferson, Kansas has the authority to regulate, warn and guide traffic upon all streets, road and highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety and because of bridge construction, the County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas have determined that it would enhance public safety to establish a temporary maximum speed limit of 35 MPH on Kiowa Road going Northerly and Southerly from a point where Kiowa Road intersects with K-92 Highway to a point where Kiowa Road intersects with 94th Street, all being within rural Jefferson County, Kansas;

IT IS THE FINDING AND RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that, in the interest of public safety and due to bridge construction, that a temporary maximum speed limit of 35 MPH shall be established for Kiowa Road going Northerly and Southerly from a point where Kiowa Road intersect with K-92 Highway to a point where Kiowa Road intersects with 94th Street, all being within rural Jefferson County, Kansas and that signs designating said speed lime be posted by the Jefferson County Highway Department at appropriate locations.

This resolution shall become effective upon publication in the official county newspaper and posting of said signs.
