

RESOLUTION NO. 08- 14

WHEREAS, Jefferson County, Kansas, (the "County") is in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 12-187(b)(1), as amended, authorized to submit to the qualified electors of Jefferson County the questions of imposing an additional countywide retailers' sales tax in the amount of one percent (1.0%) to finance the costs of constructing and improving roads and bridges for Jefferson County Kansas; and


WHEREAS, the County Election Officer has approved the attached Notice of Special Question Election, including the wording of the question to be voted upon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS, that a special question election be held in the manner prescribed by law on the 5th day of August, 2008, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the city the question of considering passage of an additional countywide retailers' sales tax in the amount of one percent (1.0%) and pledge the revenue received therefrom solely for the purpose of financing the costs of roadway construction and improvement in Jefferson County to the electors. The tax imposed pursuant to this question shall expire after six years from the date such tax is first collected. The tax imposed shall not be proportionately shared with the incorporated cities in Jefferson County Kansas. The countywide retailers' sales tax imposed may be extended or reenacted for additional six-year periods upon the board of county commissioners submitting such question to the electors at an election called and held thereon for each additional six-year period.


Resolution 07-26 is hereby rescinded.

NOTICE OF SPECIAL QUESTION ELECTION

TO ALL OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS:

Notice is hereby given by the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, (the "County") and the County Election Officer that there will be a special question election in the county on the 5th day of August 2008 for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the county the question of levying an additional countywide retailers' sales tax in the amount of one percent (1.0%) on retail sales consummated within the county in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 12-187 et seq., as amended. If approved by a majority of the electors voting [hereon, such tax will take effect on the first day of January, 2009, and shall be collected by the State Department of Revenue, with the revenue therefrom returned solely to the County.

The proposition to be voted on is as follows:

1. Shall the following be adopted?

Shall a retailers' sales tax in an additional amount of one percent (1.0 %) to take effect January 1, 2009, be levied throughout the county for six years and the revenue received therefrom be used solely for the purpose of financing the costs of roadway construction and improvement in Jefferson County and that the tax imposed pursuant to this question shall expire after six years from the date such tax is first collected. The tax imposed shall not be proportionately shared with the incorporated cities in Jefferson County Kansas. The countywide retailers' sales tax imposed may be extended or reenacted for additional six-year periods upon the board of county commissioners submitting such question to the electors at an election called and held thereon for each additional six-year period.
