WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas met in regular session on the 30th day of April, 2007 .


WHEREAS, it has been determined to be in the best interest of the public that a 35 MPH speed limit be placed on Rogers Road beginning at a point approximately 1000 feet east of the intersection of Rogers Road and Stitz Road and proceeding generally west approximately 2300 feet to a point approximately 1300 feet west of Stitz on Rogers Road all located along the north section line of Sections 5 and 6, Twp 8S Range 20E of the 6th PM.

WHEREAS, Kansas Statutes required that regulatory signs be authorized by jurisdictional authority,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, that the afore mentioned regulatory sign change shall be authorized as official.

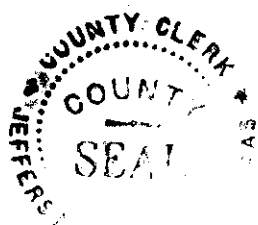


