

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-31 <sup>Limit</sup>

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED ~~LIMIT~~ OF 35 MPH ON 62<sup>nd</sup> STREET FROM A POINT WHERE THE ROAD INTERSECTS WITH K-4 HIGHWAY TO A POINT WHERE THE ROAD INTERSECTS WITH COUNTY LINE ROAD, ALL BEING WITHIN RURAL JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Jefferson, Kansas has the authority to regulate, warn and guide traffic upon all streets, road and highways under its jurisdiction; and


**WHEREAS**, based on traffic investigation and in the interest of public safety, the County Commissioners of Jefferson County Kansas have determined that it would enhance public safety to establish a maximum speed limit of 35 MPH on 62<sup>nd</sup> Street from the point where the road intersects with K-4 Highway to the point that the road intersects with County Line;

**IT IS THE FINDING AND RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** that, in the interest of public safety, that a maximum speed limit of 35 MPH shall be established for 62<sup>nd</sup> Street from the point where the road intersects with K-4 Highway to the point that the road intersects with County Line, all being within rural Jefferson County, Kansas, and that signs designating said speed limit be posted by the Jefferson County Highway Department at appropriate locations.


This resolution shall become effective upon publication in the official county newspaper and posting of said signs.
