

RESOLUTION 2005 - 44

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS, PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 8-2002, K.S.A. 8-1560 AND K.S.A. 19-101, ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON DECATUR ROAD, NORTHBOUND FROM KANSAS HIGHWAY 24 TO THE INTERSECTION OF DECATUR ROAD AND 58TH STREET, A NON-HARD SURFACE ROAD UNDER THE JURISDICTION AND CONTROL OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS; REPEALING ALL PRIOR RESOLUTIONS REGARDING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON DECATUR ROAD, NORTHBOUND FROM KANSAS HIGHWAY 24 TO THE INTERSECTION OF DECATUR ROAD AND 58TH STREET.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, desire to provide a safe and uniform maximum speed limit on a non-hard surface road under the control and jurisdiction of the Board of County Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is granted statutory authority to enact such maximum speed limit.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:


1. That the maximum speed limit on Decatur Road, a non-hard surface road, northbound from Kansas Highway 24 to the intersection of Decatur and 58th Street shall be 35 miles per hour unless otherwise posted.

2. That the Road and Bridge Department shall cause to be placed upon that roadway which is under the control and jurisdiction of the Board of County Commissioners speed limit signs showing the maximum allowable speed per hour. Placement of said signs shall be per a traffic engineering study in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (M.U.T.C.D.).


That this resolution shall be published one time in the official County newspaper and this resolution shall have full force and effect upon its publications and the installation of the speed limit signs.
