A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING A PORTION OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY COURTHOUSE SQUARE DURING THE OLD SETTLER'S REUNION FESTIVAL FROM THE PROHIBITION OF CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR ON PUBLIC PROPERTY.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS:


1. From July 10, 2003 through July 12, 2003, pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719 (e), the portion of the Jefferson County, Kansas Courthouse square specifically designated for the tasting of Kansas produced wines associated with the Old Settler's Reunion Festival, shall be exempt from the prohibition of consumption of alcoholic liquor on public property.
2. As a condition precedent to the exemption, a hold harmless/release shall be executed to protect Jefferson County, Kansas, from any and all liability resulting therefrom.
