

**RESOLUTION 2003-21**

***A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF JEFFERSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
DISCONTINUING THE NOXIOUS WEED AND NOXIOUS WEED CHEMICAL  
FUNDS OF THE COUNTY AND TRANSFERRING THE REMAINING CASH  
BALANCE TO THE COUNTY GENERAL FUND.***

**WHEREAS**, all statutory fund levy limits were suspended by 1999 Senate Bill 45, which reduces the necessity of levying taxes in individual funds to satisfy statutory levy requirements or limits, and

**WHEREAS**, it would be in the best interest of the County to consolidate funds into the General Fund, and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the County Auditor that the funds listed below be discontinued and the remaining cash balance be transferred to the County General Fund.

**NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED**, that the County Treasurer shall transfer the remaining unexpended balance in the above listed funds to the General Fund of the County on December 31, 2003, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a copy of this Resolution, as fully executed, shall be filed with the County Clerk and with the Division of Accounts and Reports, Kansas Department of Administration, upon the filing of the County's adopted 2004 annual budget; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution is in no way intended to change the adopted 2003 budget, or expenditure authority therein, of the County.
