

RESOLUTION 2012 – 002

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 30 MILES PER HOUR TRAVELING NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY ON FRAZIER STREET FROM A POINT WHERE FRAZIER INTERSECTS WITH RATZ STREET TO A POINT WHERE FRAZIER INTERSECTS WITH 19TH STREET, ALL BEING WITHIN RURAL JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Jefferson, Kansas has the authority to regulate, warn and guide traffic upon all streets, road and highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, based on the interest of public safety, the County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas have determined that it would enhance public safety to establish a maximum speed limit of 30 MPH on Frazier Street.

TRAVELING NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY ON FRAZIER STREET FROM A POINT WHERE FRAZIER INTERSECTS WITH RATZ STREET TO A POINT WHERE FRAZIER INTERSECTS WITH 19TH STREET, ALL BEING WITHIN RURAL JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

IT IS THE FINDING AND RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that, in the interest of public safety, that a maximum speed limit of 30 MPH shall be established for Frazier Street

TRAVELING NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY ON FRAZIER STREET FROM A POINT WHERE FRAZIER INTERSECTS WITH RATZ STREET TO A POINT WHERE FRAZIER INTERSECTS WITH 19TH STREET, ALL BEING WITHIN RURAL JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

And that signs designating said speed limit be posted by the Jefferson County Highway Department at appropriate locations.

This resolution shall become effective upon publication in the official county newspaper and posting of said signs.
