

Resolution 2012-019

A resolution rescinding Resolution 97-16 and establishing compensation for election board judges.

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the County Election Officer, the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, finds it essential to adequately compensate the Judges of Election of Jefferson County; and,

WHEREAS, provision for this compensation is set forth in K.S.A. 25-2811(a) and (c); and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that each Judge of Election shall receive compensation of not less than minimum wage for each hour or work as a Judge of Election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that each Supervising Judge of Election shall receive compensation of \$10.00 per election day in addition to the hourly minimum wage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that each Judge of an Advance Board, Review Board, and any other special board shall receive compensation of no less than \$30.00 for less than three hours work, or shall receive compensation of not less than minimum wage if over three hours are worked. The Supervising Judge of an Advance Board, Review Board, and any other special board will not receive an additional \$10.00 per election day

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in addition to the above compensation, each Judge shall receive mileage at the current county rate for each mile necessarily traveled in the course of service.
