

Resolution 2013-017

A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING COMMERCIAL VEHICLE TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN ROADWAYS WITHIN RURAL JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Jefferson, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2002, has the authority to regulate, warn and guide traffic upon all streets, road and highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, based on the interest of public safety and preservation of such county roads, the County Commissioners of Jefferson County Kansas have determined that it would enhance public safety to prohibit commercial vehicle traffic on the following portions of county roads:

THE PORTION OF MOONEY CREEK RD. RUNNING FROM K-192 Highway to 162nd RD; THE PORTION OF 162nd Rd. RUNNING FROM MOONEY CREEK RD. TO WISE RD.; THE PORTION OF WISE RD. FROM 162nd RD. TO K-192 HIGHWAY, ALL WITHIN RURAL JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS.


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS THE FINDING AND RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that, in the interest of would enhance public safety and protect the integrity of said roads to prohibit commercial vehicle traffic on the following portions of county roads: THE PORTION OF MOONEY CREEK RD. RUNNING FROM K-192 Highway to 162nd RD; THE PORTION OF 162nd Rd. RUNNING FROM MOONEY CREEK RD. TO WISE RD.; THE PORTION OF WISE RD. FROM 162nd RD. TO K-192 HIGHWAY, ALL WITHIN RURAL JEFFERSON COUNTY, KANSAS;


AND that signs designating said restriction of commercial vehicle traffic be posted by Jefferson County Road & Bridge Department in appropriate locations.


This resolution shall become effective immediately upon posting of said signs and shall be published in the official county newspaper.


