

RESOLUTION 2014-010

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF CERTAIN ROAD SIGNAGE
ON LECOMPTON ROAD NEAR PERRY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2002, has the authority to regulate, warn and guide traffic upon all streets, roads, and highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has the authority and responsibility to maintain signs along certain highways within the county, including certain areas of Lecompton Road near Perry, Kansas;

WHEREAS, based on correspondence with authorized personnel from KDOT regarding the placement of additional signage on Lecompton Road near Perry, Kansas, KDOT has agreed to allow Jefferson County to install additional signage as described below on Lecompton Road near Perry, Kansas;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas have determined that it would enhance public safety to place additional signage on Lecompton Road near Perry, Kansas.


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS THE FINDING AND RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that, in order to enhance public safety within the county, certain traffic signs be posted by Jefferson County Public Works Department at the appropriate location, according to the following guidelines:


1. Jefferson County will install and maintain three (3) new signs on a single post on Lecompton Road near Perry, Kansas between the existing STOP (R1-1) and STOP AHEAD (W3-1) signs. The signs will alert drivers to a school zone on US-24, show the speed limit of the school zone, and define the times in which the school zone would be in effect. The last sign's posted times must correlate with the actual times the lights are flashing on US-24 and must designate what times and dates the school zone is in effect.
2. It is anticipated that KDOT will add a small street name sign (designating "US-24") on top of the STOP sign(s). Jefferson County, Kansas will provide the street name sign(s) to be installed and maintained by KDOT.
3. The Jefferson County Public Works Department will obtain all necessary permits for the new signs to be installed and maintained by Jefferson County prior to the installation of any signs.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon posting of said signs and shall be published in the official county newspaper.


